1.1 Installation

1.1.1 With Pip

Installation with Pip is the hotness, simply:

```
$ pip install fixrate
```

1.1.2 Installing From Source

Fixation is developed on [Github](#)

You can clone the public repository:

```
$ git clone git://github.com/helaoban/fixrate.git
```

Or download the [tarball](#):

```
$ curl -OL https://github.com/helaoban/fixrate/tarball/master
```

And from the root directory, simply:

```
$ python setup.py install
```

1.2 Session

1.2.1 Session Quickstart

This page should get you up to speed on the basics of the fixrate Session API.

First, make sure that fixrate is *installed* and *up-to-date*

Connect to a FIX Endpoint

Begin by importing the session module:

```
from fixrate import session
```

Now, let's try connecting to a FIX server:

```
fix_session = session.FixSession()

async with fix_session.connect():
    await fix_session.logon()
    async for msg in fix_session:
        print(msg)
```

Now, we have a FixSession called `fix_session`.
